DISCUSSION:

Environmental Advisor will be responsible for performing functions to maintain environmental compliance and to guide company's effort to excel in environmental stewardship. General responsibilities will include providing oversight and assistance to Permian Mud Services to ensure compliance with regulations and client requirements.

SUMMARY OF JOB DUTIES:

- Ensure compliance with all relevant laws, regulations, industry practices, and client requirements – examples include air (TRI reports & PBRs), water, waste and sustainability (green house gas)
- Act as the subject matter expert for environmental issues (i.e. air permitting, waste disposal and mitigation, property acquisitions, etc.)and assist with the following activities:
 - Conducting multi-media environmental assessments and RMP compliance audits
 - Developing and implementing HSE programs/procedures
 - Preparing, presenting and coordinating HSE-related training programs
- Support the implementation and continuous improvement of the QHSE Management System which includes identifying applicable laws and regulations, conducting HSE assessments, etc.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS (special skills, knowledge, ability, education, etc.):

- B.S. degree in Engineering, an HSE discipline or similar educational background
- 10 plus years of practical health safety and environmental experience in a chemical manufacturing or upstream oil & gas operations
- Expert knowledge of air permitting requirements and one or more federal environmental regulatory programs and similar state regulatory frameworks (such as RCRA, Spill Prevention, Air Compliance or Remediation)
- Familiarity with key health, safety and environmental regulations and industry standards (e.g., ACC, API, ANSI, ASTM and NFPA)
- Excellent interpersonal and must be able to effectively communicate on all levels of the organization
- Knowledge of international regulations is a plus
